Sampadakiya....

New Year marched in with a vengeance, it seemed. As the mercury plummeted, this Midwestern town looked and felt more like a Siberian habitat. Our Hindu Temple was probably the sole exception, where crowds of people (approximately 2,000 by some estimates), unconcerned about the bonechilling cold, had assembled to welcome the New Year with the puja of Bhagwan Ganesh, God of good fortune and remover of all obstacles - material and spiritual. The unbounded enthusiasm so evident in their voices and their demeanor could assure any onlooker of the continued success of this temple. It was a day full of religious festivities that included Havana, Shiv Abhishekam, and Purnima Satya Narayan Katha. Later in the month, the temple celebrated the festivals of Lohri and Makar Sankranti with abundant verve and impressive fanfare. In the coming months, we will observe a variety of Hindu festivals dedicated to honoring various deities, revered by their followers.

The Hindu pantheon contains numerous deities, and our temple has an excellent collection of them, which aptly serve the needs of the vast Hindu community. Regardless of their faith or the chosen ishta devta most devotees would find themselves at ease around the images (pratimas) in the temple. It also facilitates many aspects of the Sanatan Dharma (as Hinduism is often identified with): Gyan (knowledge), Bhakti (devotion), karmkand (rituals), Daan (charity), Seva (service), to name a few.

For the adherents of the Gyan Marg, there are regular discourses, guest lectures, and visits by swamis in addition to

a fledgling onsite library, which is in need of expansion with the help of volunteers.

Most of the activities are around the pursuit of Bhakti—from the daily pujas to observing numerous especial religious festivals throughout the year, singing of devotional songs (bhajans), reciting from scriptures, which can assume many other forms as well. Exclusive ceremonies, such as the Rath Yatra, Janmashtami, Navratri, Ganesh Chaturthi, Maha Shiv Ratri, Sita Ram Kalyanam, Murgan Abhishkam and many more, add to the diversity of pujas available for the devotees.

On the karmakand side, services are available for performing sanskaras, from birth to death.

There are numerous opportunities for performing Daan: devotees can pick their favorite projects from a list of available ones. The entire temple has been built and maintained by the generous donation from the community.

Opportunities for Seva are also in abundance around the temple be it kar Seva for maintenance and upkeep of the temple or helping out during special ceremonies, or in the kitchen, or in classrooms; the list could be pretty long.

I am narrating this with the hope when you think of your temple you will consider the value it adds to our life in spiritual, social, and cultural pursuits. We do look forward to your continued support in years to come.





What Activating the Sun Within Really Means?

What does it really mean to activate the sun within? Sadhguru explains that the fundamental purpose of practicing Surva Kriya.

adhguru: Fundamentally, I did Surya
Kriya, but in a completely different way
than the way you are doing it right
now. In about six to eight months of
practice, no matter where I was, around 3:30
or 3:40 am, I was always up. I just had to
wake up – there was no question about it.
My sleep quota started shrinking. By the
time I was thirteen or fourteen years of age,
I was always up before everyone else.



Surya Kriya just set me on. It was not the exercise. It is just that you get in tune with that energy, and suddenly everything is on. This is what kriyas are about. A kriya is not about driving you in some direction – it is about getting into proper alignment with everything. When everything is in alignment, it is so smooth, there is no friction. Where there is no friction, there is no wear and tear, no stress. Where there is no friction, it can go on incessantly. Where there is friction, it needs more breaks.

The process of yoga is just this – on many levels – to create an alignment with the rest of the existence. The only way you will know yoga is when you are in perfect alignment. You do not have to create an alignment with something outside. If you come into perfect alignment with your own system, naturally, there will be a perfect alignment with everything. When this happens, everything will happen according to the natural order. There will be no struggle about how much to eat, how many calories to consume, how much to exercise, what to do - all this nonsense will disappear. You will just know what to do with your life, without even a thought, because the necessary intelligence

invested in this life. It is the same intelligence that manufactures your body and your brains from within.


