Nag Panchami is a traditional worship of serpents observed by Hindus throughout India as well as in Nepal. The worship

is offered on the fifth day of bright half of Lunar month of Shravan(August), The abode of snakes is believed to be the patal lok, (the seven realms of the universe located below the earth) and lowest of them is also called Naga-loka, the region of the Nagas, as part of the creation force and their blessings are sought for the welfare of the family. Serpent deity made of silver, stone or wood or the painting of snakes on the wall are given a bath with milk and then revered. According to Garuda Purana offering prayers to snake on this day is auspicious and will usher in good tidings to one's life.

From the President's Desk ...

A Mid-year Message

Dear devotees:

It is my pleasure to share with you the accomplishments of the Hindu Society of Greater Cincinnati for the first six months of the year 2018.

First, the temple Loan: as of January 1, 2018 the temple loan balance was \$ 987,193. I am very happy to state the loan balance now stands at 808,591 – a reduction in debt by \$ 178,602 during the first six months of the year. We will continue to work hard for the next six months to finally reach our goal of paying off the loan in seven years, hopefully sooner.

This year, on 22nd April, we held a special fund raising 5K Walk to pay down the temple loan. I am extremely pleased to inform we raised approximately \$23,000, which was beyond our expectations.

As you all know our community has grown in population and devotees have growing needs for religious, social, and cultural activities. Fortunately, we have four very dedicated and hardworking priests under the leadership of Acharya Kailash Sharma to serve the community well.

During May 2018, the temple celebrated *Murgan Maha Kumbhabhishekam* on a very large scale. More than one thousand devotees, local as well as from outside Cincinnati, attended the ceremonies that continued over three days. It was a very successful and well managed function. I must congratulate all volunteers,

who worked tirelessly for many months to make this happen, especially the organizing committee members — A. Balasubramaniam, S. Sivaganesan, T.M. Rajkumar, and Ram S. Mohan.

The month of June witnessed *Devi Ma Jagaran* celebration for the first time in our Temple. This occasion was graced by the melodious voices of Puneet Khurana Ji and his party from India along with our own Kailash Ji, who narrated *Tara Rani ki Katha* explaining the importance of Jagran. A sincere thanks to the Mantro and Minhas famiy and their group for their sustained support that made this function possible.

The list of celebrations at the temple is long, but I just wanted to highlight a few to illustrate the value our temple adds to our cultural and religious pursuits. Last but not least, I heartily thank all donors, volunteers, and Executive Council Members for their help and hard work without which this temple will not be where it is today - a sound and vibrant organization at the service of the Hindu community.

Temple devotees were treated to a three-day Bhagwat discourse (*katha*) by our own Acharya Kailashji. Katha started with *pothi yatra* on June 1st followed by *Bhagwat Mahatmya*.

Several definitions of word *Bhagwat* were given by Panditji: One being the four let-

ters of Bhagwat (भ, ग, व,

π) that respectively stand for *Dharma* (righteousness, moral values), *Aarth* (*prosperity, economic values*), *Kaam* (pleasure, love, psychological values) and *Moksha* (liberation, spiritual values). Together these constitute the four goals or aims of human life. Alternatively, the first letter denotes spiritual light, or strength; the second letter signifies knowledge; followed by fulfilment of dreams and the last one representing increased passion for spiritual bhakti and knowledge.

Not getting full satisfaction with his works, e.g., the *Vedas*, the *Puranas* and such, Vyas created the Bhagwatam, which is the culmination of all of his previous works. It shows us a path to God. All we need to do is make our activities God-centric rather than self-centric.

Panditji also talked about sixteen *sansakaras* (rites of passage or sacred/sanctifying ceremonies) and explained the significance of each.



In modern times we seem to perform only two of them – the wedding and the death rites. On the second and third day Kailash Ji covered all chapters of Bhagwat describing many characters and their associated stories. We learned

Narad Rishi is the intermediary between us and bhagwan. He listens to our difficulties and problems, and as a guru explains to us how can we overcome those. He guides us to a better life. Guru shows you the way. We talked about 24 Gurus of Bhagwan Dattatraya. We can identify Guru in any creature - as tiny as an ant and as big as an elephant; both were gurus for Bhagwan Dattatraya. We need to grab/use and implement good ideas from anyone or anywhere. We just need to keep an open mind and develop ways to differentiate important and unimportant things in life. Parikshit realized this and attained moksha in seven days.

Panditji talked about Bilva Mangal, Bhakt Prahlad, Bhakt Dhruv, birth of Lord Krishna, Shukdevji etc. He also explained Navdha Bhakti, nine ways to reach God. In kali yug, Bhakti/devotion is the best way to reach God. If we pray God with real passion, He is always there to help us like He did do Draupadi and Narsinh Mehta. We all can experience closeness to God.

Devotees enjoyed the discourse so much that Panditji has kindly agreed to a full seven- day *katha* in late September.





BHAHUDA YATRA Sunday, 22 July 2018 - 10 am

Ratha Yatra or Chariot Festival is associated with Lord <u>Jagannath</u> held at <u>Puri</u> in the state of <u>Orrisha</u>, India. It is the oldest <u>Ratha Yatra</u> taking place in India and the World, whose descriptions can be found in Brahma Purana, Padma Purana, and Skanda Purana. This annual festival is celebrated on Ashadha Shukla Paksha Dwitiya (second day in bright fortnight of Ashadha month

The festival commemorates Jagannath's annual visit to <u>Gundicha Temple</u> via <u>Mausi Maa Temple</u> (aunt's home near Balagandi Chaka, <u>Puri</u>.

As part of Ratha Yatra, the deities of Jagannath,his elder brother <u>Balabhadra</u> and younger sister <u>Subhadra</u> are taken out in a procession to Gundicha Temple and remain there for nine days. They are also accompanied by Sudarshana chakra. Then the deities or Ratha Yatra return to the <u>Main temple</u>. The return journey of Puri Jagannath Ratha Jatra is known as Bahuda Jatra.

Three richly decorated <u>chariots</u>, resembling temple structures, are pulled through the streets of Puri called Badadanda. This commemorates the annual journey of Lord Jagannath, Lord Balabhadra, and their sister Subhadra to their aunt's temple, the <u>Gundicha Temple</u> which is situated at a distance of 2 km from their temple. This is the only day when devotees who are not allowed in the temple premises,

such as non-Hindus and foreigners, can get their glimpse of the deities. During the festival, devotees from all over the world go to Puri with an earnest desire to help pulling the Lords' chariots with the help of other priests pulling the chariots with ropes. They consider this auspicious deed and risk their lives in the huge crowd. The huge processions accompanying the chariots play devotional songs with drums, tambourines, trumpets etc. Children line the streets through which the chariot will pass and add to the mass chorus. The Ratha carts themselves are some approximately 45 feet (14 m) high and are pulled by the thousands of pilgrims who turn up for the event; the chariots are built a new each year only from a particular type of tree. Millions of devotees congregate at Puri for this annual event from all over the country and abroad.

Hindu Temple of greater Cincinnati celebrates Rath-Yatra each year during Rath Yatra festival time with great devotion. This year is scheduled on July 14thth Saturday 4pm, all releted rituals starts from privious day. Hundreds of devotees attend and volunteers to pull the Rath of Lord Jagannath while chanting, Dancing in temple boulward. Deties are kept and worshipped in Temple basement stage for 9 days and returned back to its orginal place upsatairs main Temple 9th day with great Bahuda Yatra celebration scheduled on July 22nd 10am.


