Rates of Pujas not listed above and requiring less than four hours of priest's time will normally be \$ 101.00 (inside the temple) and \$ 151.00 (outside of temple). Rates of Pujas out of Greater Cincinnati will be \$100.00 more than the rates of outside Puja within greater Cincinnati area.





Jagannarh - The Lord of the Masses

We are living in a world where we are divided amongst one another into different categories. Society has been differentiated by caste, religion and beliefs. This tradition has been practiced for ages. There have been instances of bloodshed, devastation and violence due to these dissimilarities. Mankind has been largely split into 2 groups; those who propagate violence as a means of establishing control, and those who seek peace and harmony for all. A means of seeking peace for each individual is in the arms of the Divine Grace. In Hinduism, we worship the Trinity of Bramha, Vishnu and Maheshwara.

In this Kalyug, Lord Jagannath is an incarnation of Lord Vishnu. He is the Lord of devotion, love, affection, faith and family. It is widely -- and incorrectly -- believed that Odisha is a poor state within India. But, Sri Mandira is making our Odisha world famous. Lord Jagannath makes our state rich with culture and heritage. Our people are simple in nature and intellectual. These two things paired with each other, make us far from the "poor people" others have made us out to be.

Lord Jagannath is like sunshine. Just like the Sun shines upon a puddle of mud and a beautiful Lotus flower the same way, Lord Jagannath is present for all his devotees. Whether they are priests, kings or outcasts, Lord Jagannath sees them as equal. This is why he is called the Lord of the Masses. To prove this, every year during Rath Yatra, Lord Jagannath -- along with his brother, Balabhadra and his sister, Subhadra -- leaves the restrictive bounds of his temple and steps down among people of all races, creeds and social classes for 10 days.

A story that shows the Lord's impartiality is about Dasia Bauri. Dasia Bauri was a poor man, belonging to the lower caste and was a devotee of Lord Jagannath. One day, he wished to offer a co-conut from his coconut tree to Sri Jagannath. But, he was not allowed to do so, due to his social class. This is why he left the coco-



nut in front of the Garuda Stambha. After some time, when the priest came outside of the temple, he saw that only the coconut shell was left in place of Dasia Bauri's offering. He was astonished. At the same time, Dasia Bauri was at home, dreaming of the Lord extending his hands out of the temple to accept his offering. He woke with a start and commemorated the moment with joy. A few days later, Lord Jagannath decided to test Dasia Bauri's devotion. In disguise, He went to Dasia Bauri's home and begged for some food. The devotee was in a dilemma, as there was nothing but a grain of rice to offer. His wife, groveling in shame, prayed to the guest and asked him to accept this single grain. Impressed, Lord Jagannath decided to reward his devotee. That night, Lord Jagannath appeared in the King's dream and ordered him to provide Dasia Bauri's family (of the lower caste) with Mahaprasad from the temple every day. This tradition is still followed today, after 1800 years.


